ORDER ON MOTION TO CONTINUE TRIAL

On this 12th day of July, 2010, came to be heard the Defendant's Motion to Continue Trial (doc. 13). In the motion, counsel for the defendant requests additional time to review discovery materials and to prepare for trial. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(8)(A), the Court specifically finds that failure to grant this motion would deny counsel for the defendant the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence. Moreover, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(8)(A), the Court also finds that the ends of justice served by the granting of this motion for continuance outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial.

This case is therefore set for trial on December 6, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. Pre-trial conference is set for December 3, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. By October 22, 2010 all pretrial motions shall be filed, and they must comply with Local Rule 47.1 The government's responses shall be filed on November 8, 2010. Pretrial materials shall be filed on November 23, 2010.
